

Ocala Jeep Club Requirement and Equipment Safety List for Trail Riding

Required Equipment

- Valid Driver's license
- Vehicle Insurance meeting the state of Florida requirements
- Current state tag
- Operational seatbelts for all occupants

Recommended Equipment

- Front and rear tow points (strongly recommended)
- Fire Extinguisher (minimum 2.5 pounds, dry chemical)
- First aid Kit
- Tow Strap rated at minimum 20,000 lbs.
- FRS or GMRS radio
- ¾ inch shackles (metal or soft) (minimum of 2)
- Toilet paper
- Folding chairs

Be aware State and National Forest are NOT off-road parks. If you treat them like an off-road park and video or photograph yourself or others participating in illegal and irresponsible behavior and these images show up on social media you could be identified by law enforcement and cited for violations. If you are displaying an Ocala Jeep Club banner or sticker you will be asked to remove it and you may be removed from the Ocala Jeep Club. The Ocala Jeep Club has worked too hard with the Forestry Dept to educate our members to allow the club's image to be tarnished by irresponsible behavior. If you are not familiar with the guidelines and rules for operating motorized vehicles in our State or National Forest, we are here to educate or give guidance to anyone.

Always be prepared for problems on the trail. Bring water to drink and a full tank of gas. There are many other items you may want to keep in your jeep, a little common sense is required
